Daniel Carr presented a very informative talk and slide presentation about Franklin D. Roosevelt's 1933 confiscation of gold coins. Daniel told of FDR's Gold Confiscation Act to provide relief in the existing national emergency in banking at that time. The law required all citizens to hand over to the government via the banks almost all gold coins (US and foreign), bullion (bars, nuggets, dust, etc.) and gold certificates. Economically, banning private holding of gold was to hasten the effect of propping up the US currency. Then from 1934 on, no mention of gold was placed on our paper money certificates.
