U.S. Coins: Lincoln cent (1960 small date - proof), Liberty Head nickel (1883 “ No Cents “ - AU), Jefferson War nickel (1944 D - MS 65), 3 Mercury dimes (AU to MS 64), Liberty Seated quarter (1858 - VG), 2 Standing Liberty quarter sets (1928 & 1928 S ; 1925 & 1930), Barber half dollar (1906), 2 Kennedy half dollars (MS 65), 5 Franklin half dollars (AU 55 to MS 63), 6 Liberty Walking half dollars (F to VF)
