## FIRST NEWS OF THE 2023 MORGAN AND PEACE DOLLARS

Pricing for the Uncirculated and Proof 2023 Morgan and Peace dollars has been set by the United States Mint. The pricing was posted June 29 online through the Federal Register.

Uncirculated 2023 Morgan and Peace dollars will be priced at \$67 per coin. Proofs will be priced at \$73 per coin. The U.S. Mint also plans on a two-coin Reverse Proof set which will be offered at \$175.

So far, we don't know about mintage limits nor how many "production facilities" (mints) will be involved.
