TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 15 AT 6:30PM

This meeting was held at the Fraternal Order of Eagles, one week before our usual time to avoid conflicts with the Thanksgiving holiday.

1. Introduction of guests and new members:

- 2. Secretary's Report:
  - Current membership is at 86 members
  - We continued collecting 2023 Dues at the meeting tonight. \$10 Individual, \$5 Young Numismatist (17 & younger) or \$20 Immediate Household Family. Dues are due by 3/15/23 and will not be collected at the Christmas party.
- 3. Treasurer's Report:
  - Balance as of the September newsletter was \$12,626.31 Current balance as of this (October) meeting is \$12,835.31.
  - Report was Approved
- 4. Old Business:
  - We have confirmed that we can hold the Christmas party at the Golden Corral for Tuesday, December 13<sup>th</sup>. Pay for your meal upon entrance and join us in the private room to the left of the entrance and buffet. Please do not arrive prior to 5:30 pm
  - There will be 20 door prizes offered to membership and prizes for YN's.
  - If you would like to participate in the Secret Santa exchange, please wrap a \$15 value numismatic item and place it under the tree at the event.
  - If you have not filled out a survey for 2023 programs and your interests, please do so and return the forms to Steve D. This will help us plan educational and enjoyable meetings for next year.
  - In January we will start all of meetings with the Pledge of Allegiance.




