SECRETARY: The <u>February 2020</u> Minutes and Secretary's Report, as contained in the <u>March 2020</u> newsletter, were approved.

TREASURER: Wayne W. reported that the checks approved at the February 2020 meeting were paid. The March Treasurer's report was presented and approved.

OLD BUSINESS: Preparations are being made for the 2020 Colorado Springs Coin, Currency and Collectibles Show (Coin Show) scheduled for July 1 – 4. Phil asked whether the corona virus

would impact the coin show. Ken B will be asked at the Coin Show committee meeting Monday night.

 <u>Forint Square coin honoring Laslo Josef Biro,</u>

 <u>Inventor of the Ballpoint Pen</u> The exhibit included the 28.4mm copper-nickel commemorative, a reprint of an Argentine ad for Biro's pens, Nov. 29, 2011 Numismatic News article listing the Biro commemorative as a nominee for Coin of the Year under the Best Contemporary category, and several pens.
- 2. David J. <u>General William Jackson Palmer</u>
 David highlighted the most interesting and significant events and accomplishments of the founder of Colorado Springs and subject of the 50th Anniversary coins produced by the society and coin club, William Palmer, and displayed a photograph and badge with ribbon from the 1907 reunion of Palmer's 15th
 Pennsylvania Cavalry Regiment. The reunion was held in Colorado Springs. Palmer covered the train fare to bring the regiment here because he was paralyzed as the result of a horse-riding accident.

3. Steve D. –1896 Educational Series Silver Certificates Steve shared his \$1, \$2, \$5 bills from this series. They are remarkable for its subject matter and artwork, resulting in high demand among collectors. Instead of the portraits, mostly of former Presidents, the \$1 displays History instructing youth, \$2 displaying Science Presenting Steam and Electricity, and \$5 showing Electricity as Dominant Force in the World.
