COLORADO SPRINGS NUMISMATIC SOCIETY

EXHIBITS

1. Bob C. gave a presentation about “Devil’s Tower”, which brought to remembrance, the movie “Close Encounters of the Third Kind”. In 1906, Pres. Teddy Roosevelt made Devil’s Tower the 1st U.S. National Monument. In his presentation, Bob gave our members an interesting history of the tower and that many indian tribes are connected to it & it is a sacred site for them to use the park for ceremonies. There is a trail that goes all the way around the base of the tower. Geological studies cannot decide about its’ form. Different legends are out there; however, probably the most popular one is about the 7 indian girls & the bear & the marks seen on the tower represent “bear claws”. In addition to the history, Bob showed a medallion coin and envelopes (cancelled) with the tower on them.
2. Larry F. gave a presentation about Denver International Airport Dedication Souvenir Coin which depicts 18 different sites around Denver. This coin is beautifully made and each of the sites are very well defined.
3. George M. presented a bullion coin from Spain & one from Germany which he spoke about. The German notgeld piece was from the German States, dated 1784 and the one from Spain was a 1 oz. Silver bullion, dated 1734.
4. Milt N. gave a presentation about a missing coin that he had not been able to locate until he was going through a handful of colonial papers.....then, there it was,his a beautiful coin. In addition, he showed a coin (Saudi Arabia) & Aramco Oil Co.
